



RV RENTAL GUIDELINES 2017

1. **All RV guests must check in at the Canteen office on arrival** and settle any outstanding balance at that time.
2. All RV guests will be issued a wrist band on arrival and are required to wear the band for the entirety of their stay.
3. One representative from each rental group will be required to sign a Waiver of Liability form.
4. All guests are expected to respect the rights of others. RV guests will be responsible to ensure that all members of their party observe the 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. quiet hours.
5. RV guests must take responsibility for supervision of activities in the swimming pool. Adult supervision (age 18 and older) must be provided for those under the age of 18. If those under the age of 18 are found in the pool without adult supervision – pool privileges will be suspended.
6. If there are any problems with any of Pine Lake Camp's property or equipment, **PLEASE** call our staff at 403-848-3923. Please do not attempt to fix or solve the problem yourself.
7. No person under the age of 18 years will be permitted to occupy a tent or trailer unless supervised by an adult.
8. RV guests are not permitted to enter any buildings on the property except for the canteen and Quonset hut (washroom facilities). The only other exception is Tamarack in case of an on-site emergency such as a weather warning. In the event that you are not at the RV site please use the nearest shelter: Camp Managers' House, Basement of Dining Hall, Basement of all Lodges (Cottonwood, Willow and Spruce)
9. Pets are permitted in the trailer park area only. Pets are not permitted in camp buildings, or in pool area and must be on a leash at all times. Pet owners are expected to clean up after their pets.
10. Only one camping unit with a maximum of six persons per site is allowed unless prior approval by the Hospitality Manager has been made.
11. Under no circumstance are you to move your fire pit from its present location. Please make sure buckets of water are kept handy during campfires.
12. Speed Limit of 15 KMH must be adhered to.
13. All vehicles must be parked in the designated parking areas only. One vehicle per RV site is permitted.
14. If you have "day guests", please ensure they register at the Canteen office for the issuance of a wrist band. Please ensure your day guests park in the designated parking area, and NOT on or by your site.
15. No ATV or motorized recreational vehicles are allowed on the grounds.
16. The Salvation Army Pine Lake Camp is a smoke, alcohol and drug free campsite. Any guests found to be consuming any of these will be asked to leave the campground.
